- 1. The regularly scheduled meeting of the City of Flemington was called to order by Mayor Paul Hawkins on Tuesday, January 12th, 2021 at 4:34 p.m. in the conference room at City Hall in Flemington, GA. A quorum necessary to conduct business was visibly present via Zoom video conferencing.
- 2. Mayor Hawkins welcomed all attendees, both in person and on Zoom. Zoom participants were instructed to keep their sound muted until they needed to speak.
- 3. Invocation by Councilman Edwards and Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor Hawkins.
- 4. Councilman Edwards made a motion to accept the minutes as written for the December 8th, 2020 workshop. Councilman Dasher seconded the motion. All approved. The motion passed.

Councilman Patel made a motion to accept the minutes from the December 9th, 2020 meeting as written. Councilman Dasher seconded the motion. All approved. The motion passed.

- 6. Council reviewed the Expense Report for the month of December.

 - a. Ms. Leah Poole, CEO of the Chamber of Commerce, presented a bi-annual update which highlighted the accomplishments of the Chamber over the last six months.

Ms. Gabriele Hartage from the Liberty Consolidated Planning Commission came before Council with a request for a special event permit for the Chamber of Commerce's Taste of Liberty event which was being hosted at Flemington Village.
