1. A workshop of the City of Flemington was called to order by Mayor Paul Hawkins on Thursday, October 29th, 2020 at 4:11 p.m. in the conference room at City Hall in Flemington, GA. A quorum necessary to conduct business was present via Zoom teleconferencing.
2. Mayor Hawkins requested that all participants keep their microphones muted until ready to speak.
3. Councilwoman Smiley presented Council some suggestions to move the City towards owning and controlling its own public works through implementation of a workable plan. Possible hurdles included: no direct access to Taylor's Creek for stormwater drainage, land acquisition that would be required for a wastewater treatment plant, a shallow well would have to be dug, etc. The general consensus was to request that a grant representative from the Coastal Regional Commission guide Council on taking first steps towards the goal of City owned public works. The Council also desired that Mr. Doug Gebhardt with Davenport & Company at a future workshop to discuss possible independent financing options, as his fees for the analysis would only incur should the Council decide to enter into contract. Submission of a "wish list" for future City services and amenities was to be sent to Councilwoman Smiley for compilation.
4. Mayor Hawkins adjourned the workshop at 5:06 p.m.
