- 1. The millage rate public hearing #2 of the Council of the City of Flemington was called to order by Mayor Pro Tempore Edwards on Saturday, August 16th, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Room at Flemington City Hall. A quorum necessary to conduct business was visibly present.
- 2. MPT Edwards welcomed all attendees and shared some quick expectations of decorum for a productive public hearing.
- 3. MPT Edwards gave a presentation regarding the reasons for the necessity of a millage rate to be enacted in order to balance the budget and provide services to the citizens.
- 4. After the presentation concluded, the MPT opened the floor to public comment and asked if any member of the audience in attendance wished to speak. Although the public hearing was for the proposed millage rate, it morphed into a town hall-style Q&A session. The overwhelming majority of comments were centered around homeowners' associations, a few general questions about special fund revenues (and allowable usages), and one question about the city having its own police department.
- 5. The Council reconfirmed that the millage rate was to maintain current services and to grow; citing the need for a much larger city hall, parks and recreation, and eventually standing up a Flemington police and fire department.
- 6. With no other public comments or questions regarding the proposed millage rate, the public hearing adjourned at 6:25 p.m.

- 1. The millage rate public hearing #3 of the Council of the City of Flemington was called to order by Mayor Pro Tempore Edwards on Tuesday, August 19th, 2025 at 4:40 P.m. in the Council Room at Flemington City Hall. A quorum necessary to conduct business was visibly present.
- 2. MPT Edwards welcomed all attendees and shared some quick expectations of decorum for a productive public hearing.
- 3. MPT Edwards gave a presentation regarding the reasons for the necessity of a millage rate to be enacted in order to balance the budget and provide services to the citizens. After the presentation concluded, the MPT opened the floor to public comment and asked if any member of the audience in attendance wished to speak.

MPT Edwards opened the public hearing on the proposed millage rate at 4:58 p.m. With no audience members in attendance wishing to speak, MPT closed the public hearing at 4:58 p.m.

- 4. Councilwoman Evans made a motion to adopt a millage rate of 2.829 mills. Councilwoman Harwell seconded the motion. All approved, the motion passed.
- 5. The next item on the agenda was a resolution to place Floating Local Option Sales Tax ("FLOST") on the November 4th, 2025 ballot and the FLOST intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") with Liberty County to collect the funds should voters pass the referendum. *Councilwoman Harwell made a motion to adopt the FLOST resolution and IGA. Councilman Logan seconded the motion. All approved, the motion passed.*

- 6. MPT Edwards presented the Council with a contract for the Liberty County Tax Commissioner, Mr. Jamie Sharp, to collect property tax for the City. *Councilman Patel made a motion to execute the contract with Mr. Sharp. Councilwoman Harwell seconded the motion. All approved, the motion passed.*
- 7. After being tabled at the regular meeting on August 12th, 2025, the bid award for the City-wide Residential & Light Commercial Solid Waste Provider RFP was revisited. Representatives from both ABC Waste and Atlantic Waste were present for the bid presentation. Each company was given the chance to highlight their strengths and discuss their tipping rates in Liberty County vs. Chatham County. Both companies proposed a franchise fee of \$500.00 per month for exclusive commercial provider rights within the city, as commercial service was not included in the RFP.
 - ABC Waste emphasized their identity as a small, family-owned business, showcasing their commitment to excellent customer service, plans for a new transfer station, and quick response times.
 - Atlantic Waste highlighted their advanced truck technology, extensive fleet, plans for a transfer station in Ludowici, and also their rapid response capabilities.

MPT Edwards mentioned a conversation with Mr. Joseph Mosely, County Administrator for Liberty County, regarding an upcoming cost increase from \$15.90 to \$77.94 per property owner for the use of the recycling center and landfill. This increase is attributed to a loss of revenue for the county due to the City of Walthourville privatizing sanitation and the private provider not tipping in Liberty County. MPT Edwards asked Mr. Mosley about the possibility of negotiating the rate for Flemington citizens if the selected provider was required to tip in Liberty County; however, Mr. Mosley stated that the rate would remain unchanged. *Councilman Patel proposed a motion for the selected provider to utilize the Liberty County transfer station for tipping. Councilwoman Harwell seconded the motion. All approved, the motion passed.*

Councilman Logan expressed that both companies delivered strong presentations, but he preferred Atlantic Waste, citing greater reliability for citizens, experience serving other local municipalities, and a larger fleet. Councilman Logan made a motion to award the city-wide solid waste collection and commercial franchise for \$500.00 per month to Atlantic Waste. Councilman Patel seconded the motion. All approved, the motion passed.

Councilman Patel directed Mr. Sam Sullivan from Atlantic Waste to consult with business owners about Atlantic's pricing schedule. Mr. Sullivan stated that he would match the rates the commercial customers currently have with Liberty County Solid Waste.

8. Councilwoman Harwell made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Patel seconded the motion. All approved, the motion passed and the meeting adjourned at 5:50 p.m.




